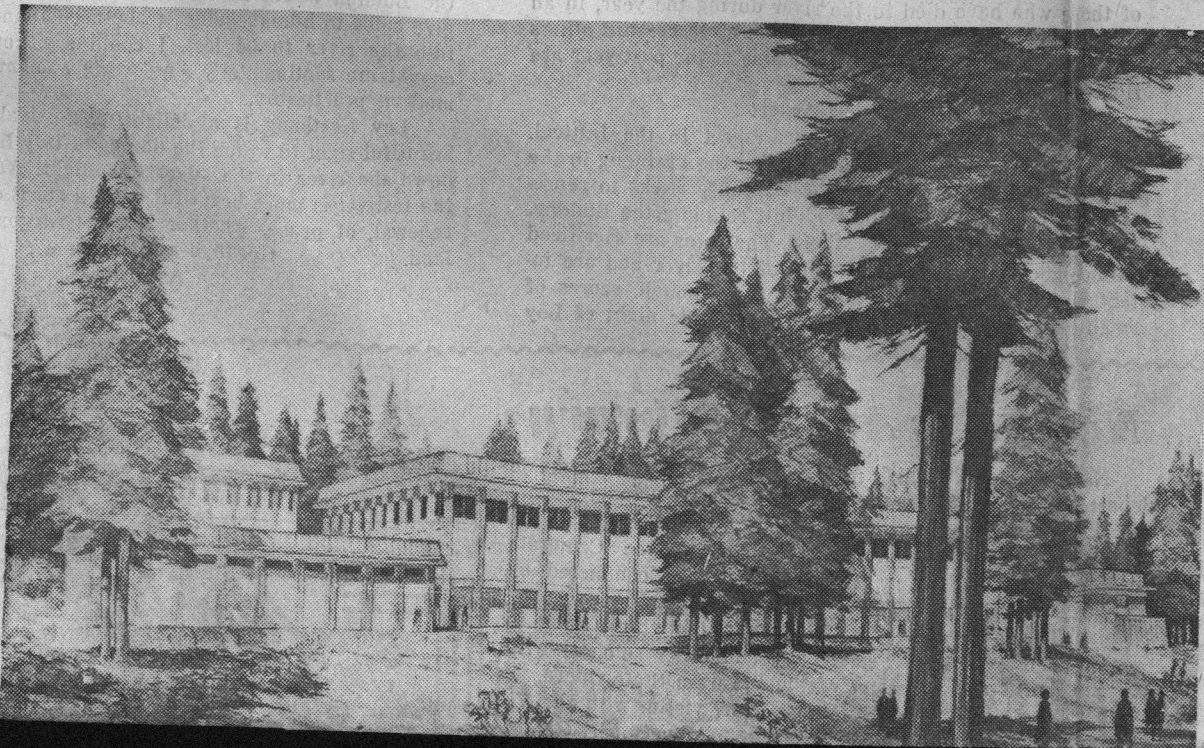
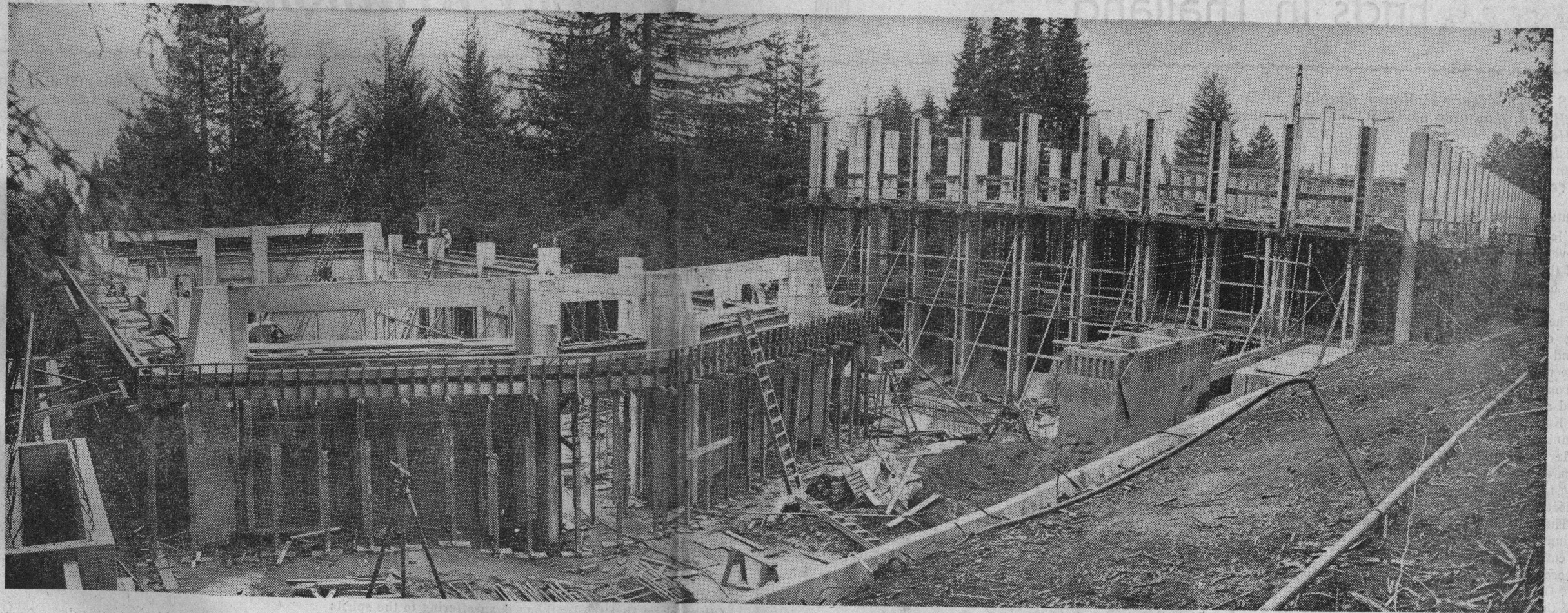


UCSC — A Progress Report



The handsome drawings are being converted to steel and concrete on the University of California campus as construction crews ready buildings for next September's first classes. Unit 1 of the natural science building, shown in the top pair of pictures, will be completed in August according to the present timetable. The lower pictures show, in skeleton and sketch, the central services building for Cowell college, scheduled for completion in May. A third

building, the field house, will be started in the very near future and will be completed by the time classes start. But the rest of Cowell college will not be ready—the schedule was delayed when construction bids exceeded the budget, necessitating further approvals by the UC regents. Bids are out on the library, and bids will go out next month on college 2. Both these buildings are scheduled for 1966 occupancy.

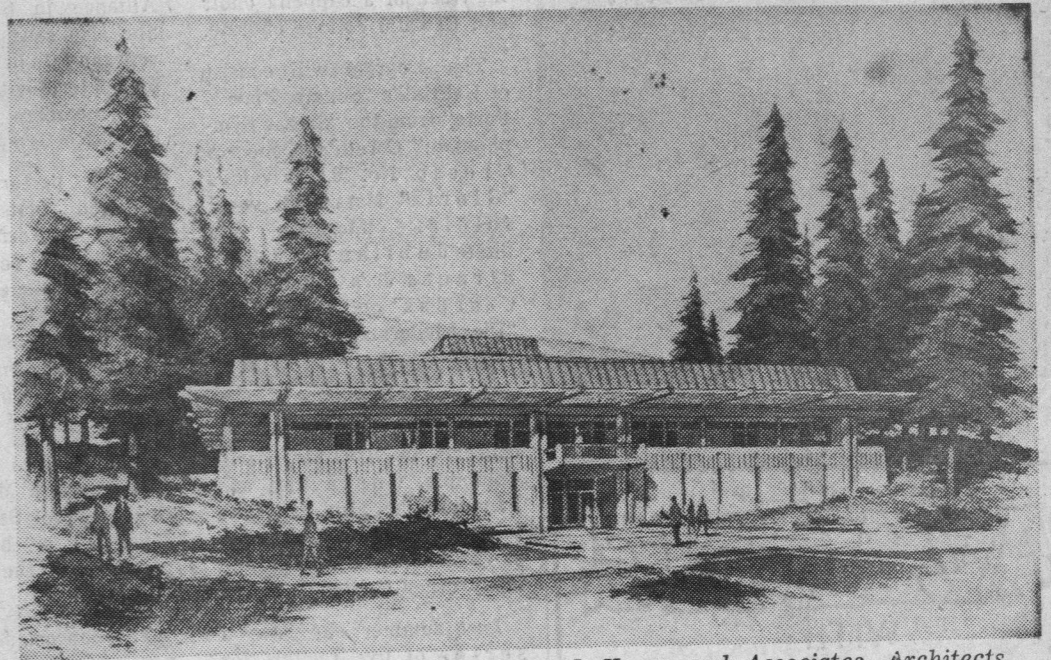
