Fair has new location

The downtown Antique & Collectibles Show was up and running Sunday in a new location.

In June, the Lincoln Street bazaar was halted abruptly by the Downtown Association, which said several vendors were disrupting local businesses, were abusive to staff members and failed to follow rules for the event.

Sunday's event was smaller and without incident. At least one vendor appreciated the new location in the Cedar Street parking lot behind Asian Rose and Mr. Goodie's.

"There's better Feng Shui here," said Avis Letner of Santa Cruz.

The City Council voted late last month to continue the fair with a new manager, Carol Elsworthy, who founded the fair in 1993.

It is held the second Sunday of each month.
