Law To Go After Hippies At Holiday

Legal wheels now are turning to either force eviction of Holiday Cabins residents in Ben Lomond or tear down the cabins.

Ray Talley, county sanitation director, said a deadline has passed for persons at the old resort to get out of the cabins. "They still are living there, so we will take the next step," he declared.

Talley will ask county supervisors on Tuesday to start abatement proceedings against the cabins.

Sewage from septic tanks at the former resort is polluting the San Lorenzo River, the health department claims. It has repeatedly ordered the cabins closed and posted the main buildings off limits for residents.

Talley said he would prefer to have the cabins razed, to be sure they are not used again by residents or transients.
