Budget hearings to start

Capitola will start putting together its 1982-83 budget April 1 by sending out letters to groups interested in applying for city revenue sharing funds.

City Manager Steve Burrell is asking for City Council approval Thursday night for a budget calendar that gives community groups until April 30 to submit revenue sharing requests, but a public hearing on proposals will be held by the Council on April 22 on the requests received up to that point.

Burrell plans to have a preliminary budget prepared by and delivered to the City Council by May

On May 20, a study session will be held on the budget and the revenue sharing requests.

Groups will be able to make presentations on their revenue sharing requests at the May 27

council meeting.

Another budget study session will be held June 3, and a final budget session and public hearing on the entire budget is tentatively scheduled for June 10.

Burrell expects to present a resolution adopting the budget, setting salary levels and revenue sharing expenditures at the June 24 council meeting.
