## Redevelopment Lot Sale **To Barrett Homes Closed**

enzo Park redevelopment land to Barrett Homes Inc. was completed

Friday.

The Richmond firm paid \$64,-620 for the parcel at Ocean and Dakota. Sixty-three cooperative apartment units will be built on it as the first phase of a 246-unit. eight-acre garden apartment complex.

This is the third parcel of San Lorenzo Park land sold by the

redevelopment agency.

Deeds were recorded Friday by Oliver Myron of Title Insurance

and Trust company.

Olin Carl White, redevelopment director, said Barrett hopes to secure final release of a \$1.3 million FHA-insured loan for the development by August 1.

"I expect they will start construction as soon as they have the

money," White said.

Barrett has placed a large sign on the property, south of Dakota

street and west of Ocean.

Plans include a six-story tower with 48 units and 15 two-story. three-bedroom garden apartments on the easterly half of the area between Dakota and Branciforte creek channel.

Sale of two acres of San Lor-Iswimming pool will be special features for owners in the cooperative.

Wilson Brothers real estate will be exclusive agents for the units.

The agency previously sold a 10-acre Ocean-Water courthouse site to the county and a small commercial parcel between Soquel avenue, Dakota, Branciforte creek, and the San Lorenzo to Joseph and Ted Alveraz.

Negotiations with Barrett have been under way since April 1960. The sale hinged on approval of the FHA cooperative apartment

financing loan.
