

Proposed East Side Elementary School Site



Pictured above is the 10-acre site proposed for a new Santa Cruz city elementary school on the East Side. The property borders Prospect Heights on its

northern boundary. Morrissey boulevard is to the east. Park way rims the west boundary of the land. The city elementary district now owns 6.3 of the 10 acres required for a school In the October 22nd bond issue election, \$45,000 is earmarked for purchasing the rest of the land. Another \$580,000 would

be used to build a school for 352 students. The school is scheduled to open by September, 1966. Another \$23,400 would be needed to furnish and equip the school.
