

Council Will Get Salary ³⁻¹¹⁻⁵² Report Tonight

Results of the job classification and salary survey recently made by the state of all city government employes, are due to be submitted to the city council at this evening's regular meeting, which starts at 7:30 o'clock in the council chambers.

The council is not expected to take any action tonight but probably will refer the survey report to the civil service commission for study and recommendations.

The survey was ordered at the suggestion of the civil service commission after city employes presented a request for a \$30 per month across-the-board salary boost.

However, councilmen are due to discuss the recommendations of the flood control and river beautification commission regarding use of the flood control tax funds for storm drain construction. A resolution passed by the commission last month recommended to the council that five cents of the allowed maximum of 10 cents per \$100 of assessed valuation in flood control tax be reserved for that purpose, while the remaining five cents could be used for storm drains.

The council has not expressed any opinion on the matter.
