

# Aerial View Of Ohtas' Guttled Home



This aerial photograph of the Victor M. Ohta home taken Wednesday by Sentinel Chief Photographer Pete Amos shows the destruction that resulted from the fire Monday night. The home was deliberately set ablaze, according to the Sheriff's department, by the slayers of Dr. Ohta,

45, his wife, Virginia, 43, their sons, Derrick, 12, and Taggart, 11, and Dr. Ohta's secretary, Mrs. Dorothy Cadwallader. So far, Mrs. Ohta's car, apparently used by the slayers in their escape, and a note left by them at the scene are the

major clues reported by the Sheriff's office. Deputies were searching the San Lorenzo Valley again today, following discovery of the car Tuesday evening after it was found in the Rincon tunnel on the Southern Pacific tracks below Felton.
