
Felton

Felton in 1930's

In the late 1930's this old Felton landmark was the site of a hobby and gift shop owned by the Beryl Melsons with a cactus garden on the right. The building was erected around the turn of the century and was used as a hotel known first as the Kramer House and then Felton Hotel. It then became a bee farm before the Melson's took it over. The Fricks of Zayante purchased it and it was used as apartments and a drug store with Dr. Steele's office in the rear. Heavenly Hamburger and A Villa of Beauty now occupy the lower floor of the building which is owned by Roy Pagnini.
