Santa Cruz and Aptos business and professional people are reporting a telephone solicitation from a female caller representing "Golden Years Senior Services."

County Consumer Affairs has learned that there is no connection with either the local Golden Age Nutrition program or the local home delivery meals service which is under the auspices of the Visiting Nurses Association and the Food And Nutrition Program which operate in the county.

Receipts given out for donations show a San Jose P.O. Box, reported Gloria Lorenzo, Consumer Affairs coordinator.
