Changing Heart Of Santa Cruz



Prominent in the center of aerial photo is the San Lorenzo Park redevelopment project area. However, other sig-nificant features of Santa Cruz are given a new perspective. Eastern portion of the revelopment area shows the patterns of grading work by Granite Construction company; the beginning of a Dakota street extension which eventually will cross the serpentine Branciforte near the San Lorenzo river flood control levees. In contrast, is the western side of the project, which will not be leveled and improved until early this summer. Some of the 300

cars which use it for parking daily can be seen. In top center of picture, Harvey West municipal park can be seen. The new Sylvania Electronic Products, Inc., plant development is

near the right upper corner. Holy Cross church retains its sharp white lines but loses some of the dramatic impact it holds when viewed from ground floor level. In the right foreground ground is Santa Cruz hospital.
