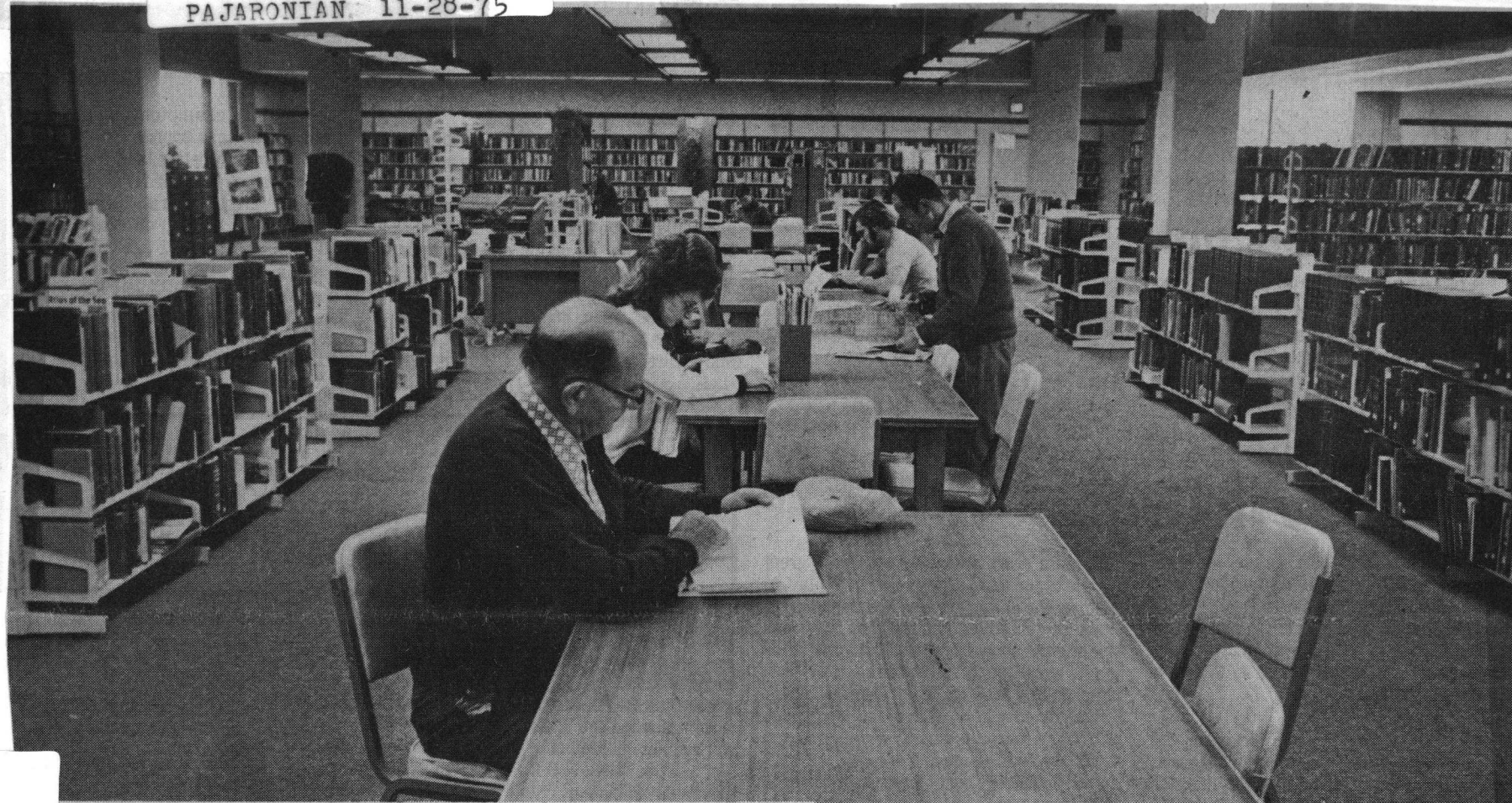




Interior of new library is one large room, giving a feeling of airiness.

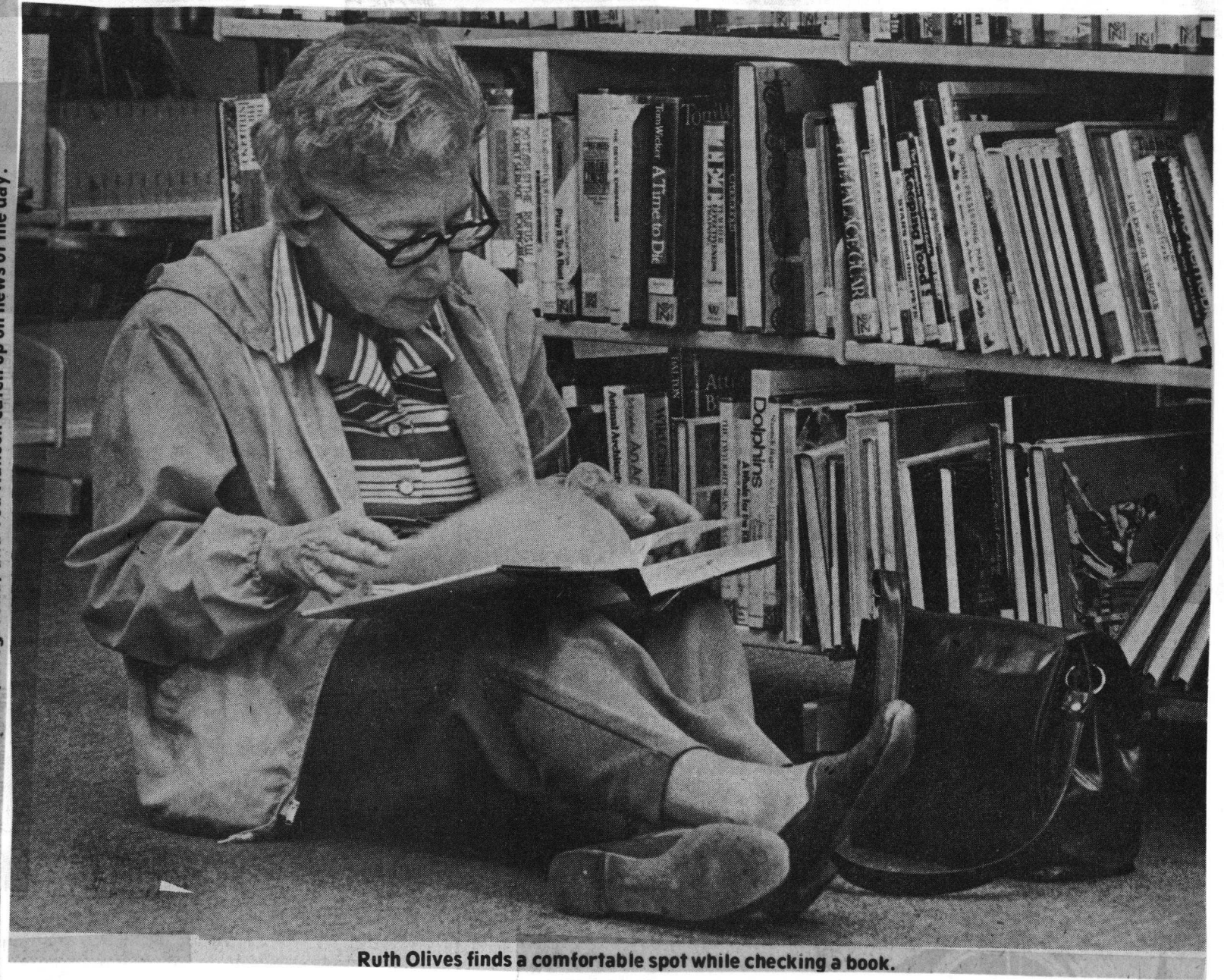

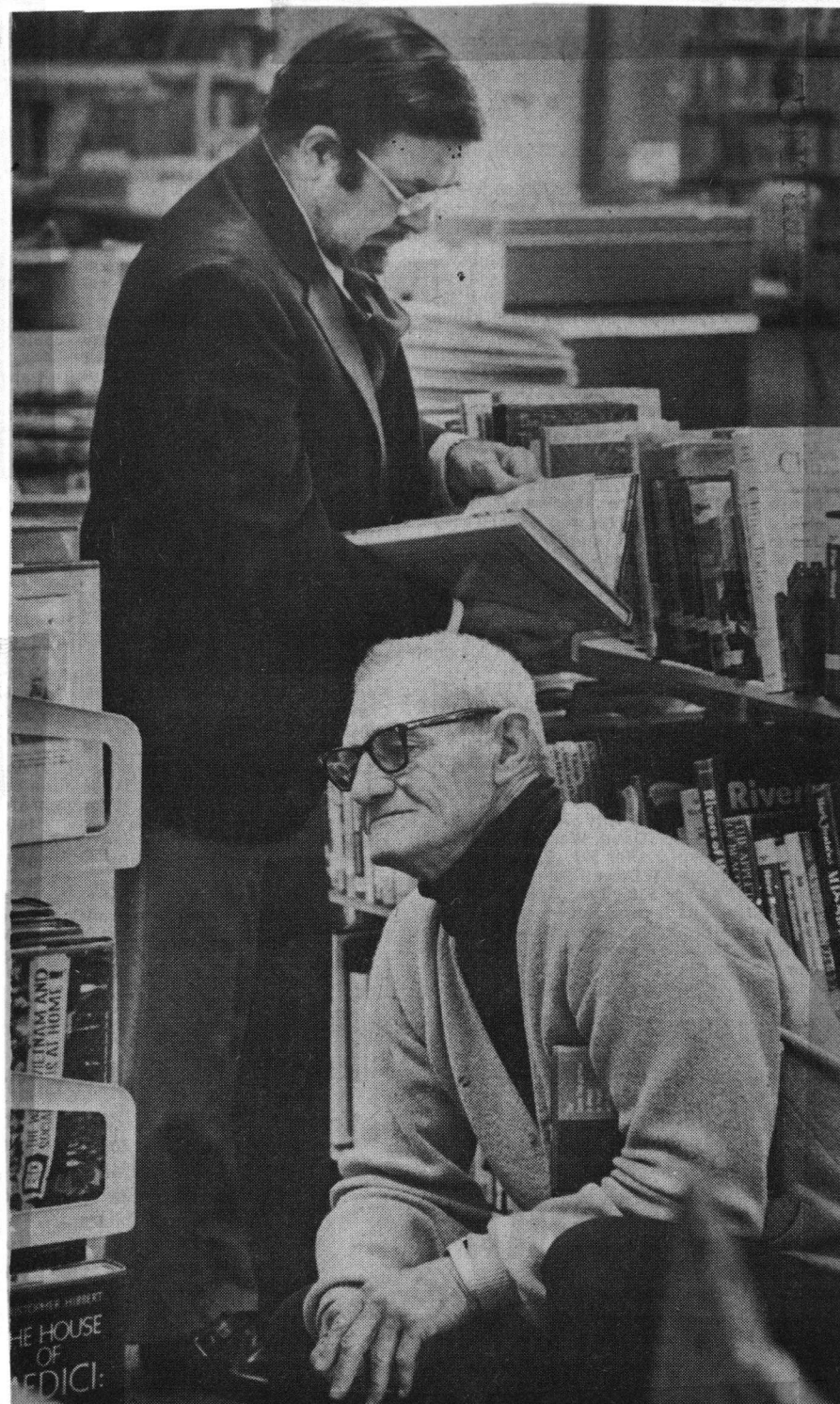
