The Davenport Jail has been reopened following completion of earthquake repairs. An exhibit of the county's north coast is on display.

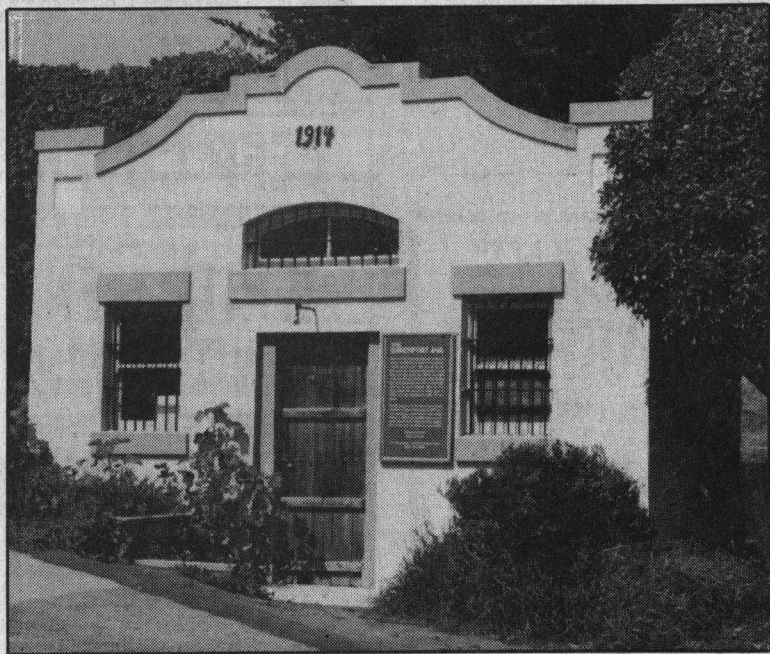
