

Once both sections are completed, only a stretch in the So-quel area will remain to make Soquel Drive a four-lane highway from Paul Sweet Road to Aptos.

County plans for Soquel already have won the backing of Soquel Merchants, Inc., and an Aptos bypass is being planned.

Other state projects in the planning, construction, or completion stage include:

SANTA CRUZ-At the quest of the city, more studies are being made on a freeway along the Chestnut Street area between Mission and Bay Streets.

The freeway would connect Highway I west of the city to the Highway 1—Highway 17 interchange.

The beach loop route 100 is also a part of the state's study. It is designed to carry traffic around the downtown business district to the beach areas.
