98 Degrees Sets Record For July 14

Remember July 14, 1926? That's when the Santa Cruz temperature hit 92 degrees and set a new high for the day since local record-keeping began in 1890.

Tuesday, the temperature soared to 98 degrees, and July 14, 1981, found its way into Ron MacDonald's record books.

Tuesday was also the hottest day of the year as the previous 1981 high was a 97 on June 16.

This morning's early risers were greeted by extensive fog which extended

along the entire West Coast.

After predicted, the fog lifted by midmorning, and the pattern should remain the same through Thursday, according to the National Weather Service.
