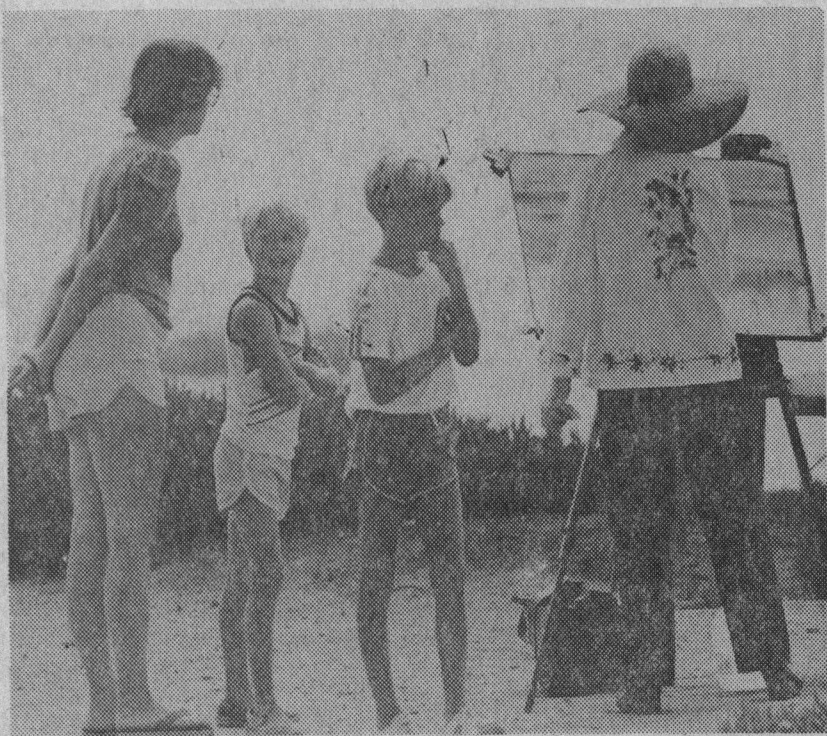

A Watercolorist's Paradise

The Santa Cruz Watercolor Society, led by local watercolorist and teacher Marian Goodman, is out in force each Friday — recently along the West Cliff Drive cliffs.

Goodman leads the large group — armed with watercolor paints, brushes, bottles of water and small folding tools — to artistic sites throughout the county.

A favorite haunt, according to Goodman, is

along the beaches. "The variety of ocean and bay scenes here is endless — beaches, waves, spray and breakers. No other watercolor society has such an array of splendor at its very doorstep."

Goodman formed the local society in 1972 as an offshoot of the Santa Clara County Watercolor Society. They now number around 75 members.
