then the Bartlett property. Pieces
were sold to Henry Skinner, now
the only residence remaining (it
is opposite the First Methodist
church); to John Ennor (now the
city library parking lot for years
a select boarding house operated
by the Ennors).

The Locust street Hihn residence
property was disposed of to D. C.
Fargo and Harry Street.
