

## Giant Sequoia Is Dedicated

Fred Brandt, the Examiner special correspondent, in his description of the dedication of a giant sequoia by Admiral Rodman, says:

The giant sequoias dedicated to Generas Grant and Fremont, Theodore Roosevelt and Admiral Evans were pointed out to the admiral and his party before a stop was made at Cathedral grove, one of the outstanding groups in the wilderness of mighty sentinels. Here a sequoia that is said to be more ancient than the Sphinx or the Pyramids was selected for dedication to the commander of the Pacific fleet. The ceremony was of the simplest kind and Admiral Rodman was not called upon for an address. The machinist crew aboard the New Mexico will make the bronze plate that will be used to mark the Admiral Rodman sequoia, as the tree will henceforth be known.
