New La Selva Library Near Completion

The new library at the La Selva Beach recreation building, 314 Estrella Avenue, is now in final stages of construction, according to county librarian Mrs. Geraldine Work.

The library will be a 1200-square-foot annex to the recreation department and should be completed by November 1, Mrs. Work said.

The library will have 6000 books, magazines and newspapers.

Mrs. Work also said hours at the Freedom library have been expanded to 1 p.m. to 9 p.m., Monday through Thursday, 1 p.m. to 6 p.m., Friday, and from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m., Saturday. She stated that a number of people have been reading the books for Spanish-speaking students.

A cooperative agreement was reached between Watsonville, Freedom and La Selva Beach recently whereby a person may use any of the libraries without extra charge, she said.
