Aptos Has New, Larger Postoffice

After 17 years Aptos has a new place to mail its letters. The new postoffice is on Trout Gulch road, around the corner from the Bay View hotel.

It was built by Fred Toney, owner of the Bay View, and leased to the government.

Mrs. Amey Weiser, postmaster for two and one-half years, has worked with the postal department in Aptos for 17 years.


She said the new building has 1500 square feet of floor space and is three times as roomy as the old building next to the Village garage.

The new structure is fire proof and contains 450 letter boxes, 100 more than the former building. It will be maintained by three clerks, two rural carriers and two substitutes in addition to Mrs. Weiser. All furnishings are owned by the government.
