A House For The Lord

From the "Little Brown Church By the Sea" with a handful of regular members in 1890, Twin Lakes Baptist Church has grown to a membership of 1,750 — and a new two million dollar church plant.

It took 83 years, a lot of work and faith — and The Word. Word of God, according to Dr. Roy Kraft, who has worked at it since 1943.

The new church plant will hold open house Sunday from 2-5 p.m. Public invited.

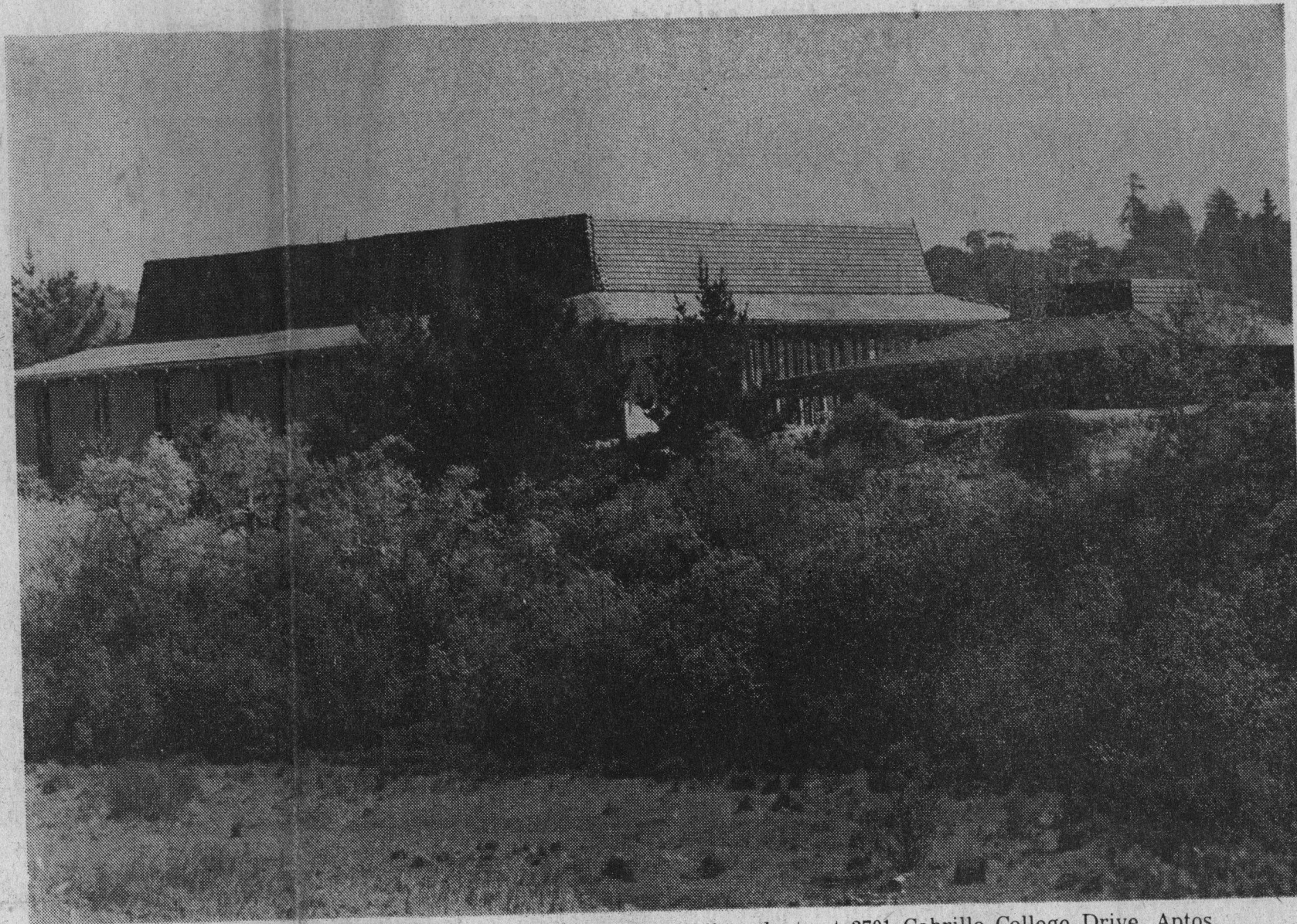
The new plant will be dedicated with formal ceremonies September 16 at 11 a.m. and 7 p.m.

The present three new buildings total 53,800 square feet. Design and engineering was by Ifland Engineers, Inc. General contractor was Bogard Construction, Inc.

Five more buildings are planned, four for education, one for a fellowship hall and gymnasium.

The present church staff totals five ministers and eight other personnel.

Concert Series

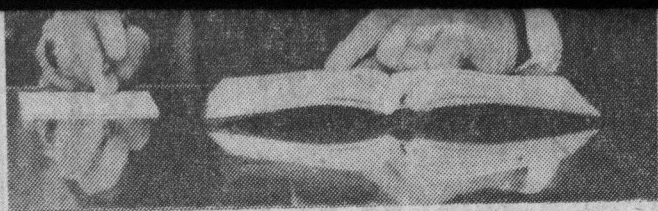
A sacred concert series is planned at the new Twin Lakes Baptist Church.

Proceeds from all concerts go toward purchasing a custom, four manual Rodgers Organ.

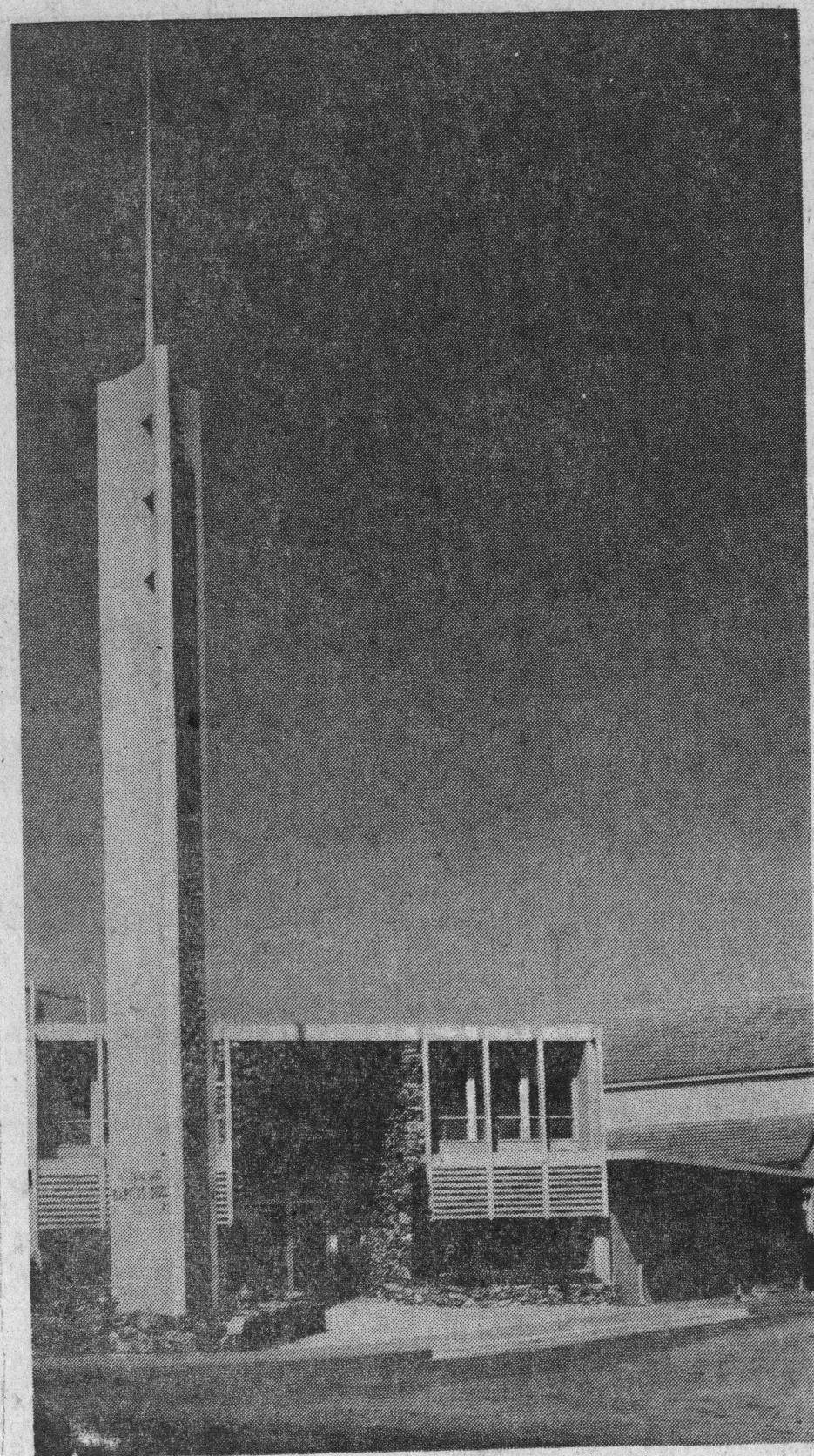
