Russ News Agency Tells Of Weightless Space Man

Moscow (AP). — Maj. Yuri A. Gagarin said today he worked on his notes, and even ate and drank while objects were floating around in the realm of weightlessness as he orbited the earth, the Soviet News agency Tass reported.

The Soviet astronaut, Tass said, described the eerie situation in the space ship when weightlessness took over.

During the entire flight, he asserted, he was in complete control of the way and phase of the flight.

Emphasizing he was no mere passenger as his space ship circled the earth at a maximum altitude of 188 miles, Gagarin told Tass:

"I was entirely concentrated on carrying out the flight's program. I wanted to carry out every point of the assignment and to do it as well as possible. There was a lot of work. The entire flight meant work."

While the space ship was under ground control for the landing, Gagarin helped with
