

'Traveling' Church Ends Career



The "traveling First Baptist church" yesterday came to its final rest in a cloud of plaster dust . . . the "going—going—gone" sequence left the historic building leaning at this angle briefly before it was flattened. The church has

been a Santa Cruz landmark at the corner of Walnut avenue and Center street since 1887. Original portion of the building, a 50 by 30-foot structure, was moved down Walnut avenue thaty ear on rollers

from the original church location on Locust street hill. The property was purchased for \$75,000 through Penniman Santa Cruz County Title company with purchasers undisclosed. Ed Winn Realty handled the transaction.
