## Bird Watchers Club Is Formed In Santa Cruz

A club for bird watchers will soon be formed in Santa Cruz. The specific purpose of the new club will be to study wild birds, with emphasis on conducted field trips.

A steering committee meeting for the new club took place Monday evening at the home of Mr. and Mrs. Frank Reinelt, 344 Arroyo Seco. Harry R. Smith, past president of the Illinois Audubon society and the Chicago Ornithological society, headed the meeting and will later lead field trips. Smith is also co-author of the book, "A Distribution List of Illinois Birds."

The first official meeting of the club has been scheduled for January 9 at 7:30 p. m. in the music room of the Santa Cruz public library. Officers will be elected at this time and committees appointed.
