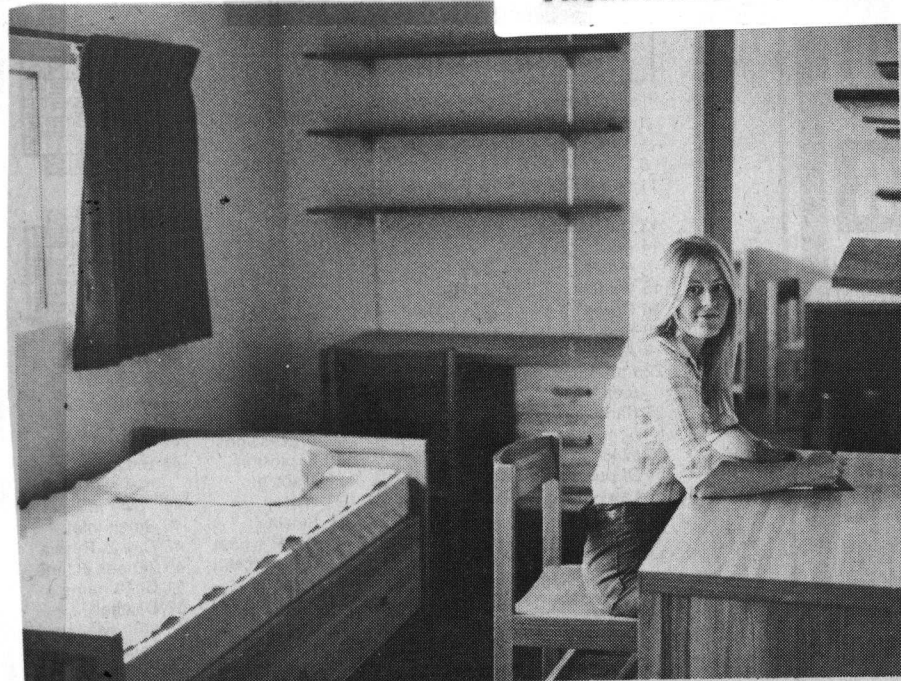

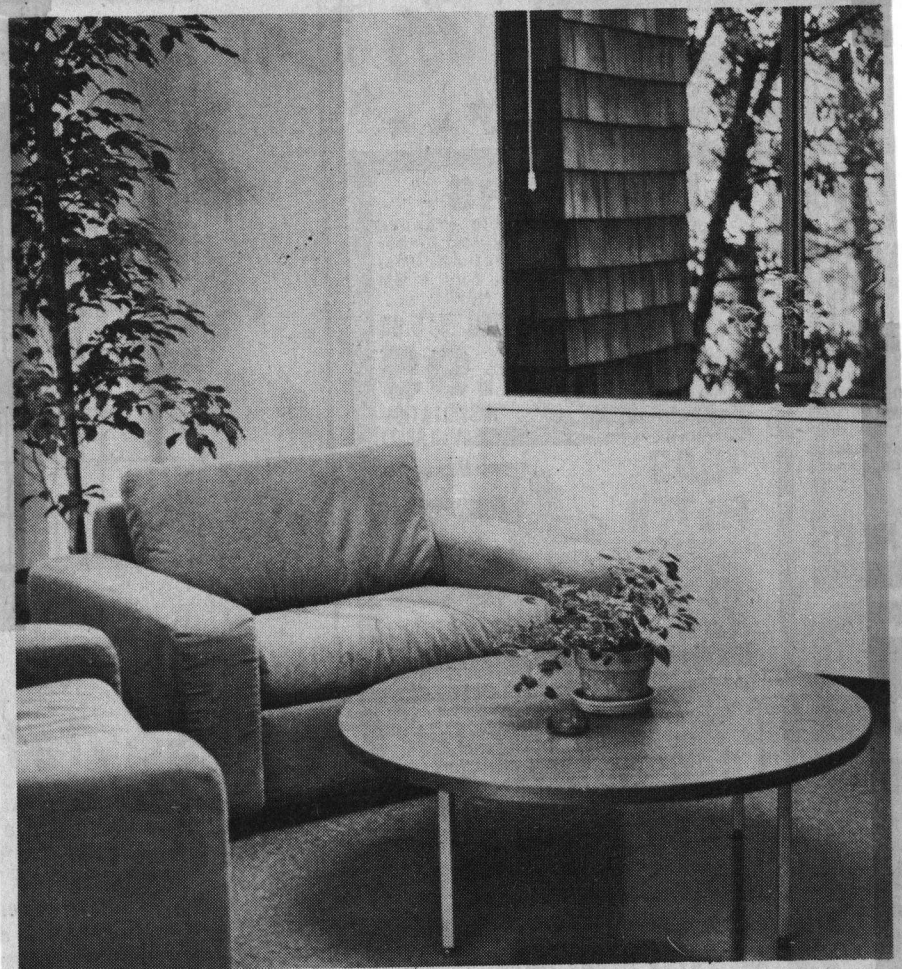
Carol Artman checks out a room in the apartment complex.

New college opens doors

The major part of Oakes College, the seventh at UCSC, has now been constructed, and will be open to students attending school during the fall quarter.

The \$8.85 million project involves about \$500,000 in tax money, with the bulk of the project being paid for through bonds, which will be repaid through student housing fees.

Now complete are an academic building and a student residential complex, with a student commons and tutorial-research center scheduled for completion in spring of next year.
