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# Watsonville Looks For More Open Space

The City of Watsonville is forming a cultural and recreational citizen's committee in order to better use open space in the Pajaro Valley.

Contrary to some reports,

the committee is not lobbying for daily public use of the county fairgrounds, but rather bet-

ter use of Pajaro Valley recreational facilities in general.

Watsonville Mayor Bill Johnston said he has invited different branches of government to work on the committee as well as representatives from the county fair board, local

high schools and Cabrillo College.

Johnston said the function of the committee is to take an inventory of facilities in the Watsonville area and to study possible improvements.

Fair board member Charles

Spencer said reports the committee was seeking the opening of the county fairgrounds on a daily, park basis were "not true in any manner, shape or form."

The committee will seek official recognition and approval at the Watsonville City Council meeting Tuesday.
