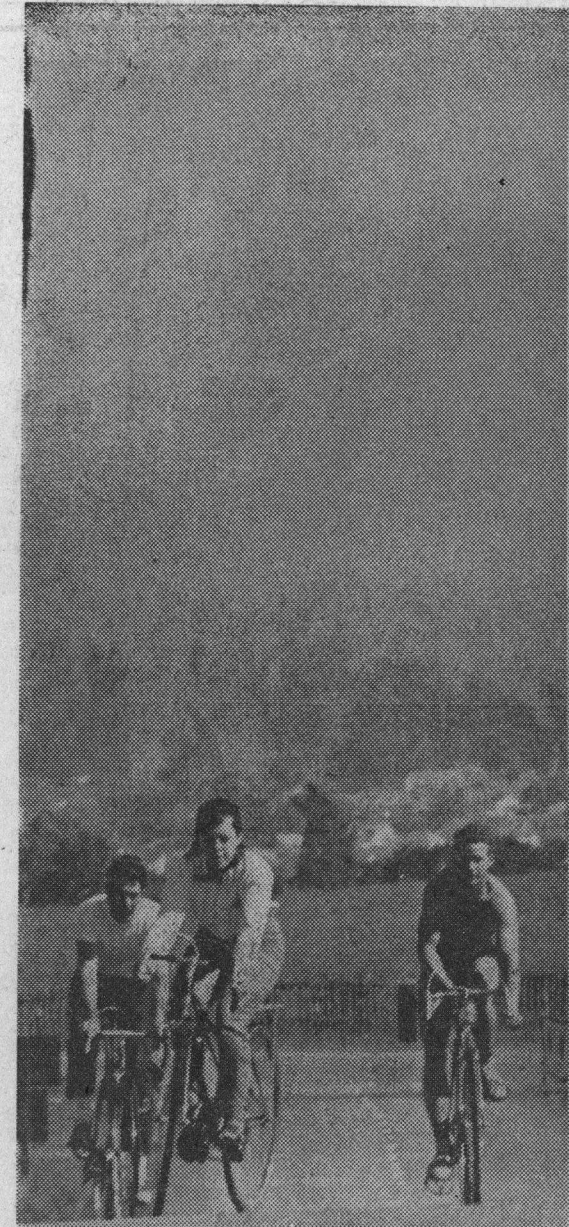
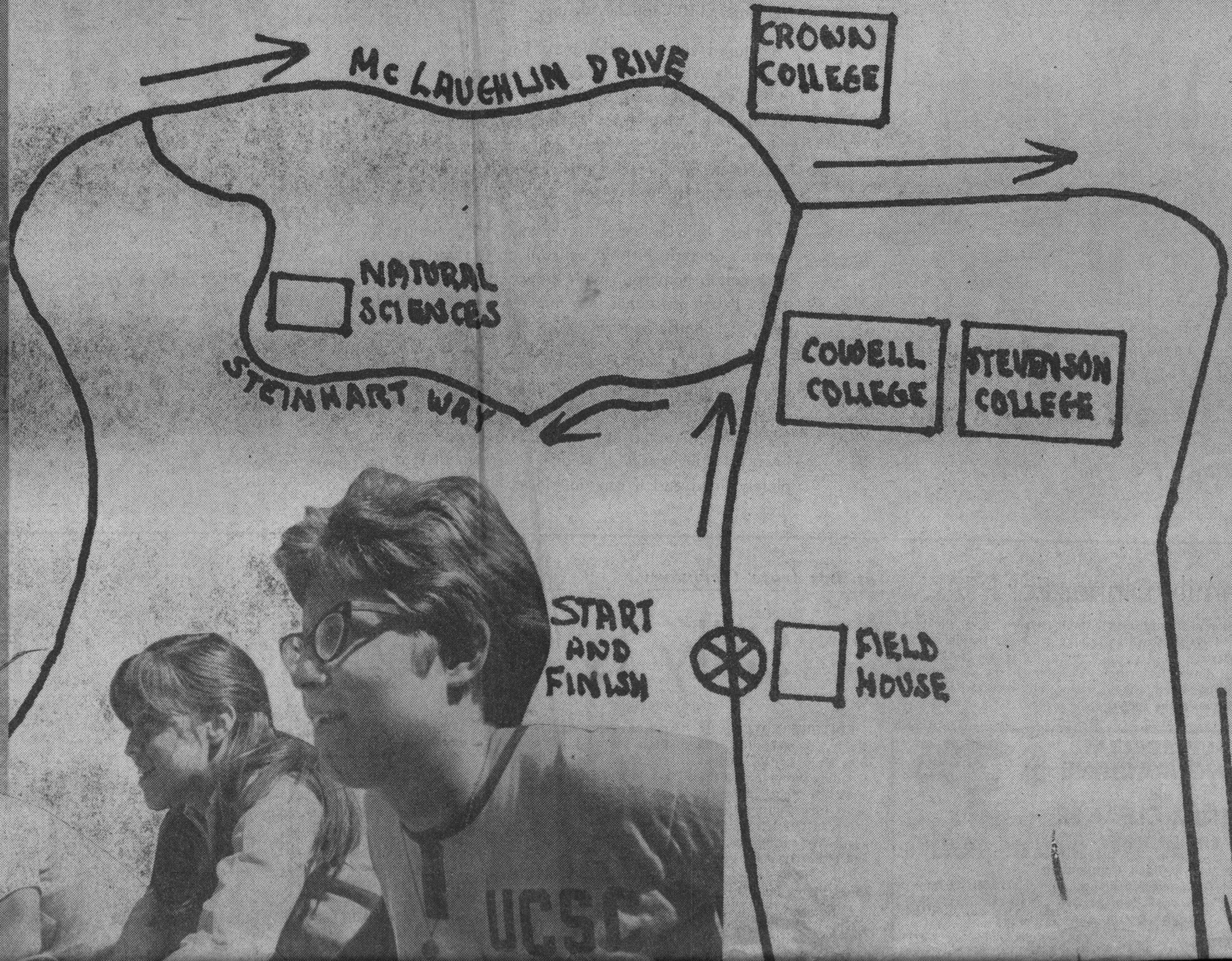
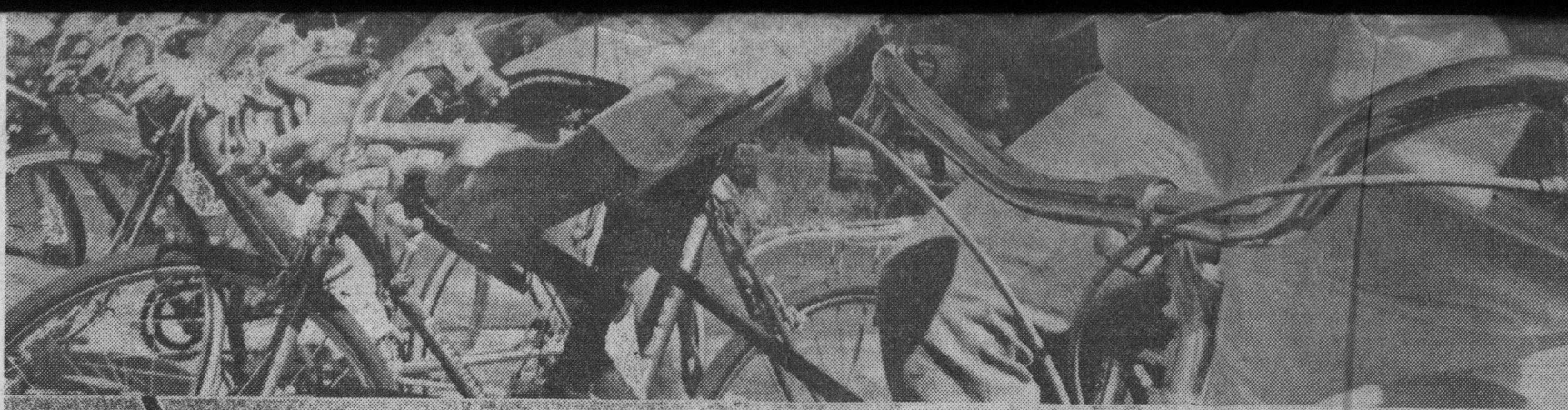


TOUR de SANTA CRUZ



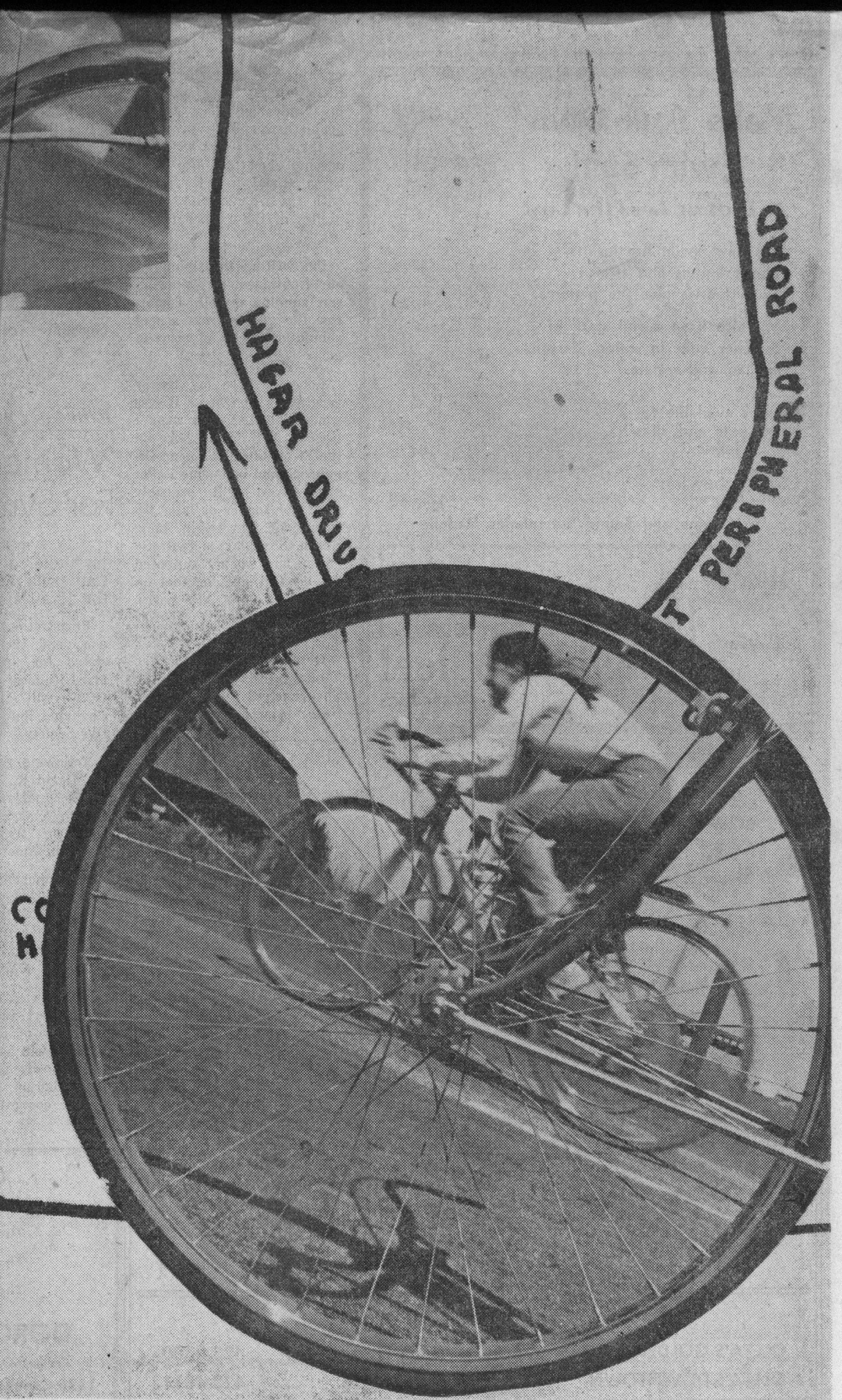


Santa Cruz, already famous in a number of other rights, now bids fair to become a big wheel in the world of two-wheelers.

The first annual Tour de Santa Cruz, a championship bicycle race billed as the grand prix of that sport, is slated here May 25 and 26. The event is expected to draw top stars of the sport, and could place Santa Cruz squarely in the center of the bike racing map.

The big race weekend will begin Saturday at 9 a.m. with a bicycle rodeo for local youngsters at Front and Laurel Streets. The cross country race, whose route is outlined on this page, will get underway on the UCSC campus at 1 p.m.
