\$105,000 Live Oak Fire



An explosion and fire leveled this building at 1039 17th avenue last night. It had housed the Wayne Manufacturing company and the Steve Scofield Surf Shop. The estimated loss was about \$105,-000. Two Santa Cruz High

school journalism students, Wayne Norton and John Reynolds, who were at the fire, said seven fire units from Live Oak, Capitola and Soquel could not save the building. The alarm was given at 8:56 p.m. by Mrs. Dorothy Wey-

nacht, 1724 Kinsley street, Live Oak, who heard the explosion. Towering flames created a red glow seen from Mission street in Santa Cruz. Charles Cox, owner of the Wayne cabinet factory, put his loss at \$75,000 for the

building and \$20,000 worth of materials. Scofield put his loss at about \$8000 in surf board merchandise. Cause of the fire is unknown. The building was owned by Derald Struble of Capitola.
