
# Santa Cruz Captures Tournament

## Cardinals Triumph, 55-54 On Griffin's Stuff Shot

Larry Griffin made his best high jump of the year, stuffing the ball through the hoop for the winning bucket just two seconds before the buzzer, and the Santa Cruz Cardinals won the ninth annual Dads Club Invitational basketball tournament in the civic auditorium last night.

Griffin's shot gave the Cardinals a 55-54 victory and their first tournament title since Steve Smith's shot at the buzzer beat Monterey in an overtime period in 1961.

A crowd of 900 partisan fans went wild, mobbing Griffin like he was Ringo of the Beatles.

It was a tough defeat for Monterey to absorb, for the Toreadors were not given much of a chance at the title before the tourney began. One thing is certain, Monterey Bay League followers now realize that Regis Hurley's crew is going to be a team to reckon with when league play begins Friday.


Monterey appeared to have the game wrapped up with a three point lead at 54-51 with 50 seconds to play. But Buddy Smith got free for a layup and the Toreadors set up a stall.


Monterey made a looping cross court pass with about five seconds to play. Up went the older Griffin boy, who scored 22 points in the game. He grabbed the ball, dribbled down court, jumped and stuffed the ball down through the bucket.


The Toreadors led through out most of the first period and then Santa Cruz blitzed the net to take a 25-16 lead with 3:45 to play in the half.

But Monterey could not be counted out. The Toreadors fought back and tied the score with 4:10 left in the game at 45-45 It went to 47-47 and 49-49 and then the Toreadors took a three point lead with 1:45 to play as Bill Stratton made a free throw and




