Municipal Golf Course

In order to open the Municipal Golf Course in De Laveaga Park on schedule next summer, it is necessary to plant the seed on fairways, greens and tees by the end of September. All efforts of the contractor, City forces and utility company personnel have been directed to this end and it appears that the schedule will be met. Water and power have been delivered to the large lake located on the 18th fairway and the contractor has installed a battery of three pumps to drain water from the lake and distribute it onto the golf course. Piping and electrical work has been done so that sprinklers can be operated. The contractor is placing a mixture of sand, redwood soil conditioner, fertilizer and mushroom compost on the greens. This will provide a good soft base for the greens area.

Pacific Garden Mall

The Pacific Garden Mall is progressing on schedule and completion is expected prior to the Christmas shopping season. All planters, tile work and sidewalks have been completed north of Cooper Street and some specimen trees have been planted. Street lights have arrived and the street light poles are being prepared so that the lights will be installed as soon as possible.

A large wooden begonia planter at the Cooper-Church-Locust intersection has been donated by the three large business establishments in that area. Lumber for this and other wooden structures has been donated by Santa Cruz Lumber Company.

Mrs. Evelyn Morris and Chuck Abbott are working hard in coordination with S.C.O.P.E. to obtain money for installation of five pools and fountains near the Plaza. These would be splendid memorials and could have suitable plaques designating donors. Attractive specimen trees are urgently needed and donations for the purchase of trees are requested. Gifts of fountains, walls and planters are also being sought.

Soquel Avenue Bridge

The bridge is on schedule and should be completed by Thanksgiving. The City Council has awarded the contract for bridge approaches. This work should be completed at the same time as the bridge and be usable during the Christmas season.
