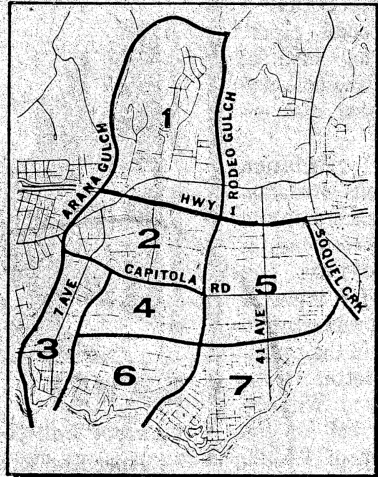


Live Oak residents asked to help with general plan

The Live Oak General Plan Advisory Committee (LOGPAC) has prepared the following questionnaire to obtain the opinions and suggestions of those unable to attend neighborhood meetings.
