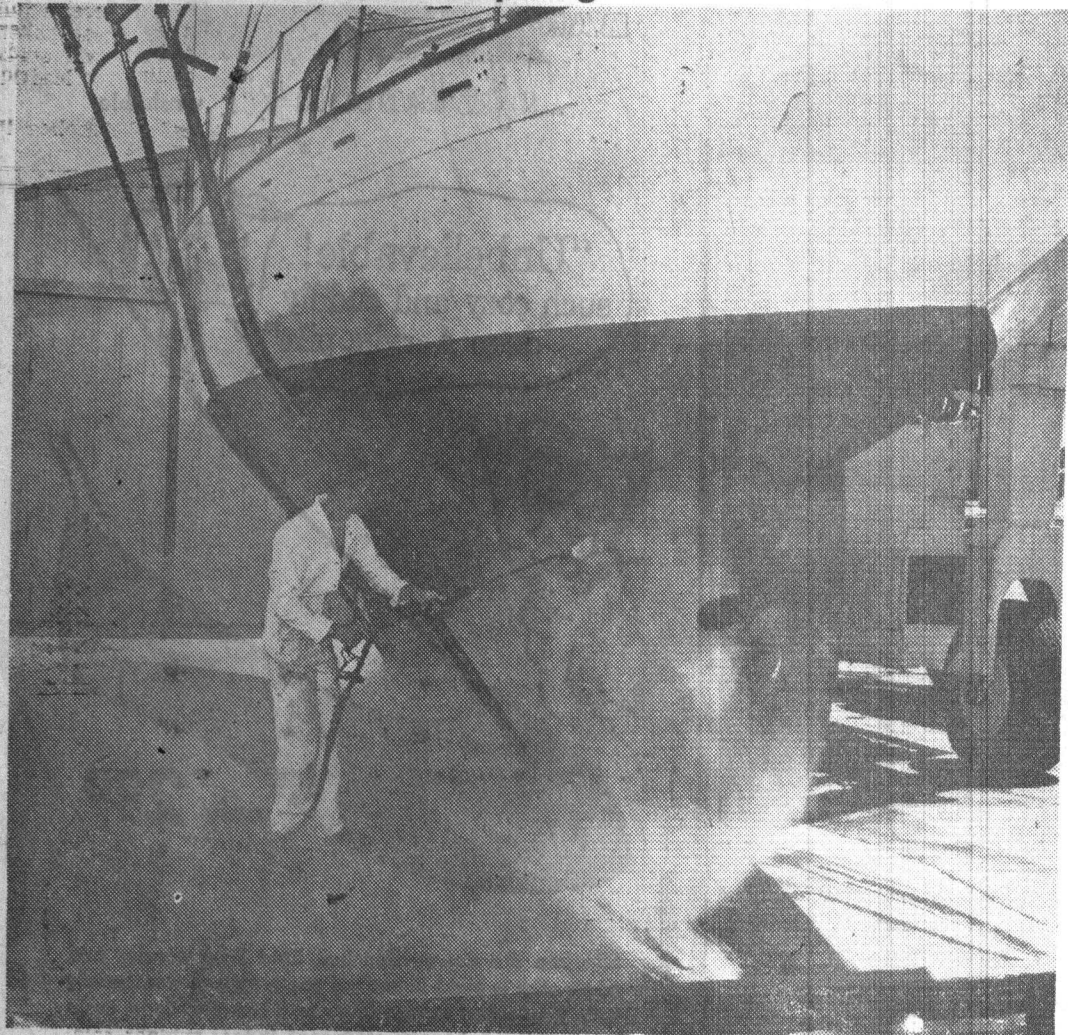


Boat Clean-Up Begins At Harbor



Boat owners have begun cleaning up their boats after the anchovy invasion of the Santa Cruz small craft harbor. Here Walt Thomas, partner in the Harbor Marine repair yard, uses a steam cleaner on a large sloop, the Pegeen, out of San Francisco. Steam is needed to get the heavy oil sludge off the boats' bottoms. The oil, left by the dead fish, eats away the bottom paint. A majority of the boats in the harbor will need new paint jobs.
