

# ✓ Supervisor repays \$1,392.01 <sup>Board of Supervisors</sup> to county 12-6-85

SANTA CRUZ — Supervisor E. Wayne Moore has repaid to the county \$1,392.01 — the amount Auditor Art Merrill says the supervisor owed in private telephone calls and non-business use of a county car.

Merrill says he has closed the books on the Moore case.

The auditor said today he has prepared a letter for the Board of Supervisors following a review of information his office has collected. He said he and Moore met several times to go over the case.

At issue was a variety of telephone calls which Moore charged to the

county. Merrill said "any call of questionable nature" was considered non-business. The total, he said, amounted to \$1,291.15.

Merrill said his office calculated that Moore's unauthorized use of a county car amounted to \$100.86. The total — \$1,392.01 — was repaid by Moore.

Merrill said his office is in the process of compiling a list of guidelines for internal control over telephone use by county employees. A final report to the Board of Supervisors will be presented in February, he said.
