Official opening delayed

The Grand Opening of the Capitola Mall has been delayed one week.

Ceremonies marking the opening of the county's regional shopping center at 41st Avenue and Capitola Road will be held Thursday, April 21, said Bryant Gorton of Sutter Hill this week.

"We've delayed the opening until the 21st," said Gorton, "so that more of the Capitola Mall stores will be able to finish construction and open."

"We feel too that with the high percentage—85 per cent—of the available space leased, the delay will allow more square footage to open and make us a better retail facility."

Originally, the mall had been scheduled to open on April 14.

Plans have already been approved by the city of Capitola for construction of a Lucky's food store at the north end of the center, across the parking lot from Mervyn's department store. San Francisco Federal Savings and Loan has received approval for a large office at the southwest corner of Clares Street and 41st Avenue.
