Quilt On Display At County Fair

A heritage quilt made by local women for presentation to the city museum will be exhibited in the City of Santa Cruz Bicentennial Committee booth at the county fair Sept. 10-14.

Also on display will be a presentation on the Town Clock restoration, which is one of the city's major bicentennial projects. Brochures of the Bicentennial Medallions, of special interest to collectors, and pamphlets of historical significance locally will be distributed.

The booth will be No. 25, according to Carol DeWitt, a committee spokesman.

The committee, which is not to be confused with the local political organization of the same name, is spearheading the city government's efforts to recognize meaningfully the metropolitan observance of the nation's 200th birthday.

Committee chairman is Billie Mahaney. Other committee members are Doyle Foreman, Nancy Eidam, Edith Prince and DeWitt. Council liaison member is Joe Ghio.
