four-pound bass and 14-inch trout, according to what they told him. Their tales only whetted his desire to land a few of his own.

The conditions at the reservoir are almost ideal for fishing. The water, while about 10 feet below the rim of the reservoir, is clear with 12-foot visibility.

"The rainfall is still below average, and the lake is a little lower than it typically is for this time of year," said Bill Kocher, the city's water department director. "But it's not low enough that one would be thinking in terms of restrictions."

The park hours are from 6 a.m. until sunset — about 6 p.m. Entry fees are \$4 per car and \$1 to walk in. Canoes and other "car-top" boats are charged a \$2 launch fee, while boats on trailers are charged \$5.

The limits on fish are five trout, five bass, 20 catfish and all the sunfish you want, according to Cacace.
