Plan to save cliffs advanced

A plan to use rip-rap and concrete to halt the cliff erosion and shore up the Crest apartment buildings in Capitola was presented Wednesday night to the city's architectural and site review committee.

Submitted by the Washington and Jensen engineering firm, the plans calls for rip-rap to be placed on the beach at the eastern end of the county sanitation district's sewage pumping station in an attempt to halt cliff erosion that is threatening the safety of the apartments on the 100-foot-high cliff. New underpinings would be constructed under the exposed apartment foundations.

The plans will be submitted to the planning commission before final city approval of the project is granted.
