Our family summered in the village of Capitola by the Sea for many years. In 1958 my father bought the property at 325 Vista Dr. in La Selva Beach. It had dirt floors, no running water, an outhouse, and the sink was in a lean-to behind the house. When he brought the family to see it for the firs time we thought he was out of his mind. We moved in to the home in the summer of 1959 and summered here for the next fifteen years.
