Watsonville Band leaving for another European tour

The Watsonville Band and more than 300 of its fans and supporters take off tomorrow for another of their by-now legendary foreign excursions.

This time the ultimate goal is Expo '92 in the historic Spanish city of Seville. But before they arrive in Seville, two weeks after departure, they will have visited many of the great cities and tourist meccas of Europe, with the band giving public performances at most of them.

The entourage leaves from San Francisco International Airport tomorrow afternoon and will return on July 1. They will visit London, Paris, Madrid, Costa del Sol, Granada,, and North African locations before arriving in Seville on June 28.

The band will play concerts at nearly all the stops, including one at Euro-Disney World, which is just outside Paris and opened in April.
