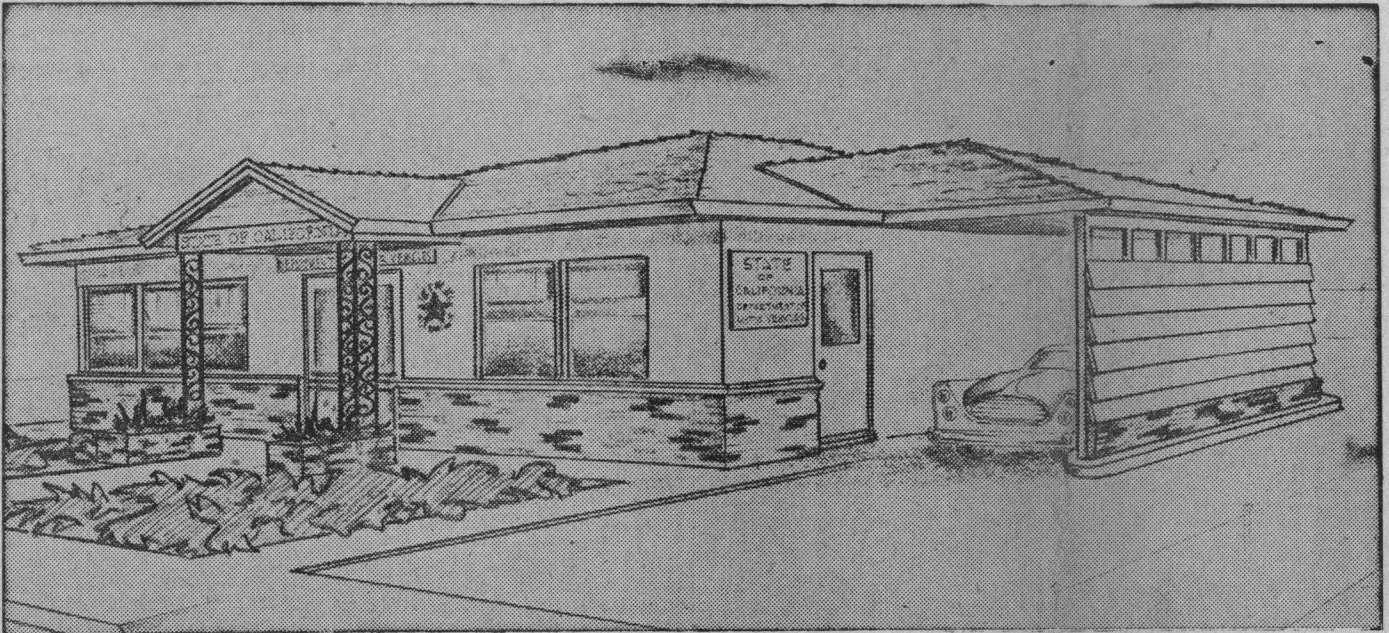


New Motor Vehicles Building



Construction will get under way Monday on a new state department of motor vehicles building at 440 May avenue, for the Santa Cruz area. Designer and Engineer Norris A. Houk reported that the 2000-square-foot structure will cost approximately \$30,000. The present MVD office at 1411 Soquel avenue will be torn down to make way for the new Lucky Stores, Inc., building.

New State Motor Vehicles Building To Be Constructed

A new state department of motor vehicles building will be constructed at 440 May avenue.

The structure, containing 2000 square feet, is expected to be completed by April, Designer and Engineer Morris Houk reported. Plans call for a large 30 by 40 square foot reception center for the public, a shake roof and a brick front.

Houk stated the building will have fluorescent lighting and there will be an inspection station at one side of the office for out-of-state vehicles. A 26-car parking lot is earmarked for the rear of the building.

The state department of motor vehicles is leasing the building from owner Louis Bei. Handling the construction work is the Cagage and Pinckney building company.

Located at 1411 Soquel avenue, the present DMV structure will be torn down to make way for Lucky Stores, Inc. Construction will begin Monday.
