With a strong onshore wind keeping the surf below its usual height, two Army landing boats spent Tuesday afternoon approaching Santa Cruz County beaches between Seacliff and Manresa. Early in the day, two crew members were dropped ashore at Seacliff, to be fetched later in the day, but most of the landings were dry runs. The Army boats, which carried members of the U.S. Army Reserves from Rio Vista, left local waters late in the afternoon for Monterey, where they were to dock overnight, an Army spokesman said.
