Donlevy Named A City Manager


Assistant City Manager John Donlevy has been named city manager of Foster City and will take the \$31,000 a year post on Jan. 5.

Donlevy has worked in City of Santa Cruz administration since 1968, first as combined assistant to the city manager and as personnel director, then as assistant manager. He got the latter job in 1969. Current pay is \$22,000.

Donlevy said he will actually leave the city Dec. 19 to take a scheduled holiday trip to the Carribean with his three sons, John, Jeff and David.

Foster City, Donlevy told the Sentinel this morning, is a completely planned city of 22,000 persons. It's planned development is to a maximum of 37,000 persons, he said. The city is among 18 incorporated cities in San Mateo County.

Donlevy said he could not turn down the opportunity offered to work as a city leader, but he expressed deep regret that he is leaving his post under City Manager David Koester.
