## May deadline set for LO general plan

The Live Oak General Plan Advisory Committee (LOGPAC) set a schedule for its meetings and work sessions Monday, and announced tentative plans for completion of a full citizen's committee report by May.

The next LOGPAC session will be a regularly scheduled neighborhood committee meeting at 7:30 p.m. Dec. 6, but these committees will adjourn at 8:15 p.m. for work sessions by subject groups. Subject committee reports will be given during a short general open session Dec. 13, and will be followed by further committee meetings that evening.

County planner Dennis Pisila said there may be another subject committee meeting Dec. 20, but that is not definite. A regular neighborhood committee meeting will be held Jan. 3, and a full general session will be held Jan. 10.

At the Jan. 10 general meeting, the group will review reports of the service, circulation, parks, open space and conservation committees. A tentative meeting has been set for Jan. 17 for the

presentation of reports by the land use and housing subcommittees.

Dick Dugan, LOGPAC co-chairman, said he feels a full citizens committee report with maps, committee reports and alternative plans may be completed in May or sooner.

During a meeting of the land use subject committee on Monday, Frank Evans, co-chairman, arranged to meet with several other committee members to study general plan concepts and

to formulate a sketch for a plan based on current land use, current zoning and the 1961 general plan. The results of this study will be presented to the land use committee during subject committee sessions.

LOGPAC's community questionnaire was also released for publication this week (see page 3). Dennis Pisila said a computation of the results will be presented to the committee after the forms are returned to the county planning department.
