## \$30 millions in state grants

Santa Cruz County will be getting emergency grants totalling \$30 million under a plan announced by Gov. George Deukmejian to distribute \$122 million in state emergency funds.

The governor yesterday ordered the immediate expenditure of \$17 million from the state's emergency reserve account to the seven counties hardest hit by the Oct. 17 earthquake. Santa Cruz County will receive \$5 million. Monterey, Alameda and San Francisco counties will each receive \$3 million. San Benito, Santa Clara and San Mateo counties will receive \$1 million to help pay for earthquake damage.

Deukmejian also notified the Legislature yesterday that he will allocate another \$100 million from the state's reserve account to help local government pay for repair or replacement of government facilities and meet their bills for additional overtime, supplies and other earthquake-related costs.

Santa Cruz County will receive \$25 million. San Francisco, Alameda and Monterey counties will each receive \$15 million, and San Benito, Santa Clara and San Mateo counties, \$5 million each.
