The provost for College at the University of California at Santa Cruz has been named by the UC regents, Chancellor Dean McHenry and President Clark Kerr announced today.

Charles Hunt Page, chairman of the department of sociology and anthropology at Princeton university, has been named to the post. McHenry said Page "is at home in both the social sciences and humanities, is an effective teacher, and is highly regarded by his colleagues. We are indeed fortunate to have a man of his caliber to head our second college with its modern social science emphasis."

Page will take up his duties here in September. College 2, to be completed in September, 1966, will have 700 students, with 450 living on campus. The college buildings were designed by Joseph Esherick, and will be built by contractors Williams and Burrows.

Professor Page received his bachelor's degree in history at the University of Illinois, and received his Ph.D. in sociology from Columbia university. He has taught at City College of New York, Columbia, and Smith college, and has been at Princeton since 1960.

He has written "Class and American Sociology," is co-author of "Society," which has been published in several languages, is co-author and co-editor of "Sociology and Contemporary Education," and is co-editor of "Freedom and Control in Modern Society."
