

Davenport Quarry Back In Operation

Work at the Pacific Coast Aggregates company quarry above Davenport is back in full running order, General Superintendent Art Anderson said this morning.

The railroad tracks from the quarry to the cement plant which were covered last Tuesday by a huge slide have been uncovered, power lines have been restored and water mains repaired.

The slide covered 1600 feet of the railroad line and it was estimated last week it would take about three weeks to repair the damage. But Anderson said everything was put back into shape by yesterday afternoon.
