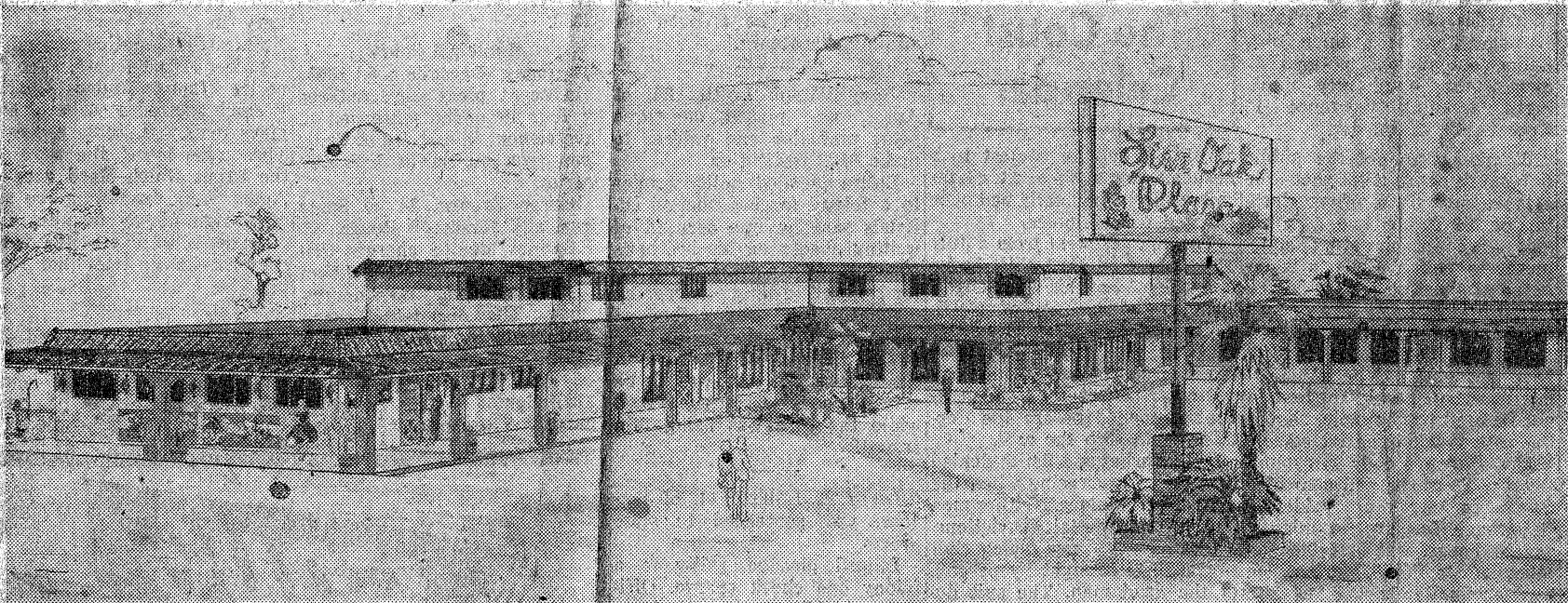


# Live Oak Plaza Shopping Center Under Way



Work has begun on the new \$200,000 Live Oak Plaza shopping center at 17th and Brommer Avenues.
