

tions, Seller said the center will handle industrial payroll processing, research analysis, and the bookkeeping and billing in accounts receivable, among other things. The center will be located on a one-acre parcel of land, with 10,000 square feet of floor space, or about 23 per cent of the total site. More than twice as much parking as required will be provided, he said. The building is scheduled for completion by March 1, 1967.
