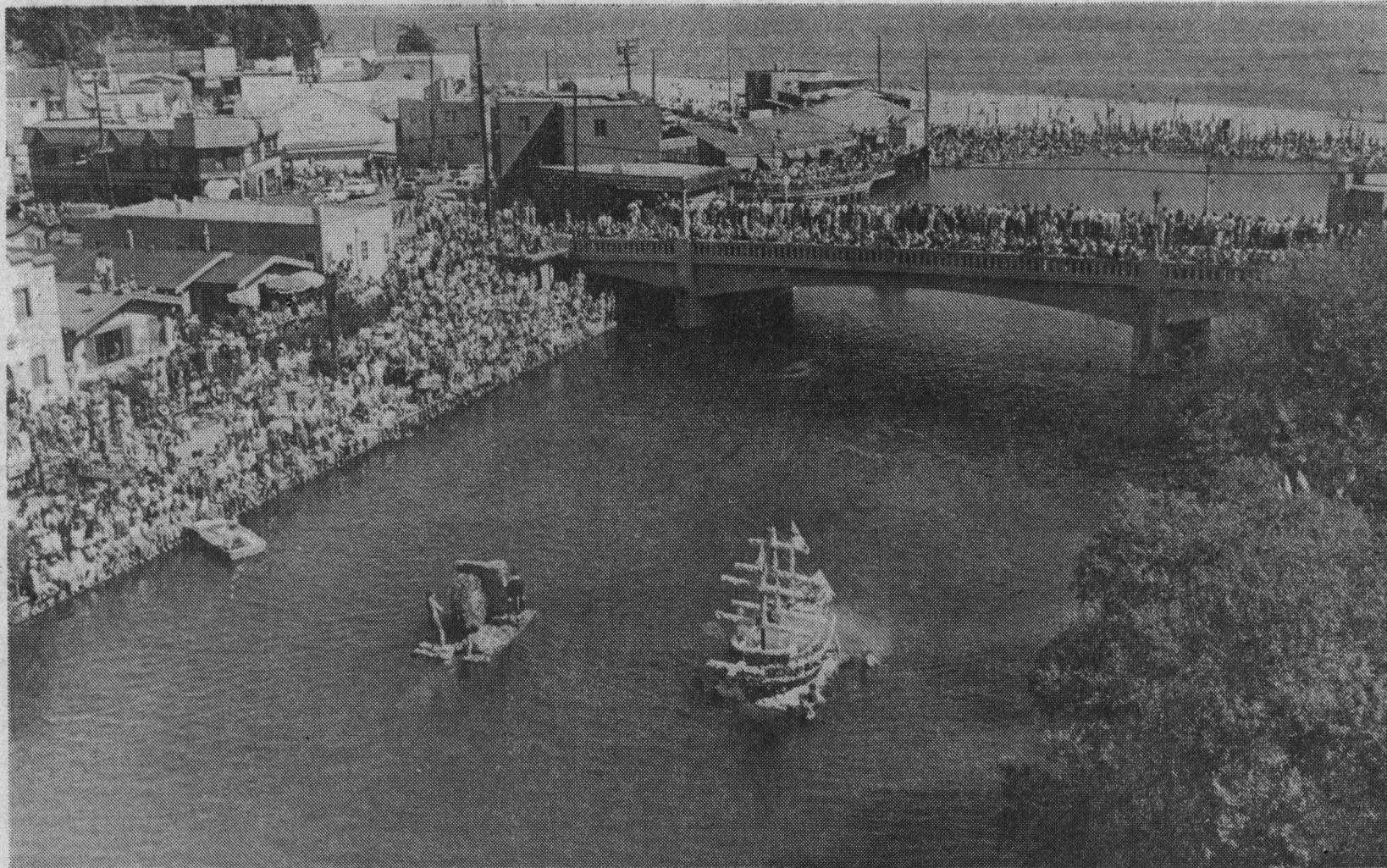


Capitola Begonias Aplenty
