Chestnut Street Cut-Through Opens Tomorrow



Chestnut street cut-through to Mission street and the freeway will be officially opened at 7 o'clock tomorrow morning. The first vehicle to use the street will be a Santa Cruz. Transit company bus chartered to carry approximately 40 Santa Cruz area civic leaders to an all-day tour of the Fresno downtown area. The Fresno tour is sponsored by the Downtown advisory committee of the Greater Santa Cruz Chamber of Commerce, Mayor Norman Lezin will cut the ribbon opening

the Chestnut street project, which cost approximately \$250,000, including right-of-way acquisition. Lezin said the cut-through is "the first of several major capital improvement programs needed to implement the city general plan."
